The truth is, scaling doesn’t just magnify your wins—it magnifies your weaknesses. The systems, habits, and leadership style that got you here won’t get you to the next level.

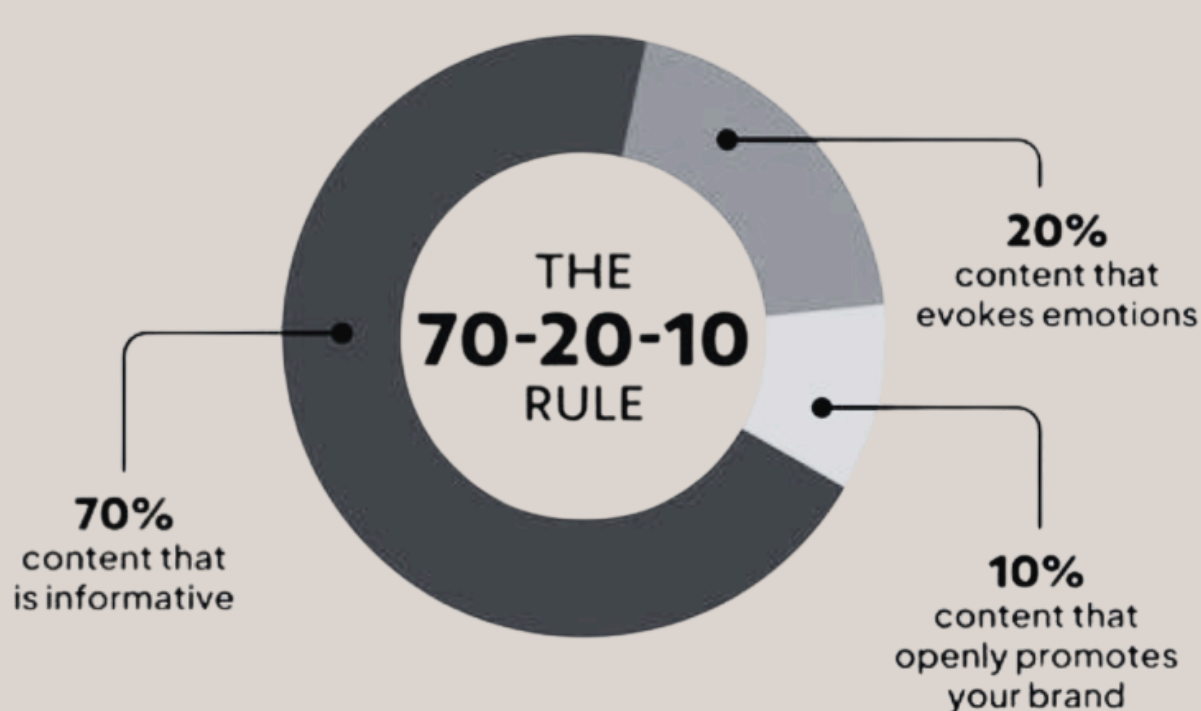


HERE ARE THREE FRAMEWORKS I SHARE WITH FOUNDERS AND EXECUTIVES NAVIGATING GROWTH WITHOUT BURNING OUT:

1. THE 70/20/10 RULE FOR FOCUS

- **70%** → Keep doing what works. Double down on proven revenue drivers.
- **20%** → Experiment. Try new channels, new offers, or new partnerships.
- **10%** → Bet on the future. Explore bold ideas that may not pay off yet.

This structure helps you avoid “shiny object syndrome” while still leaving space for innovation.

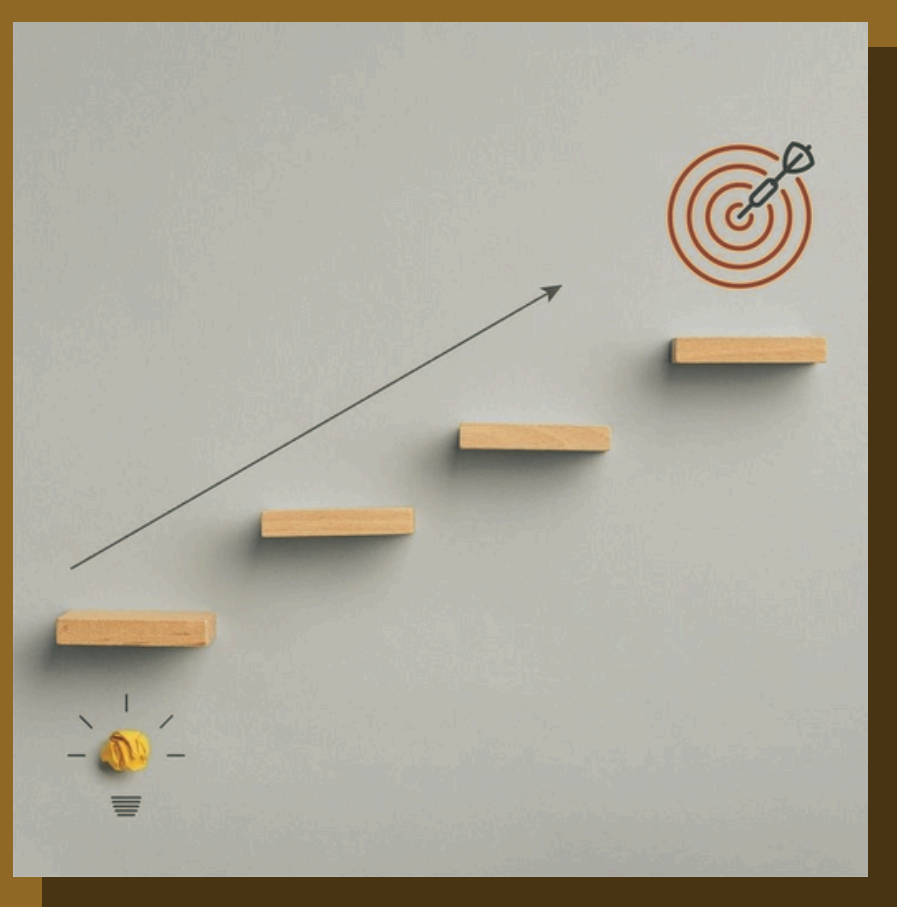


2. THE DECISION LADDER

When everything feels urgent, don’t solve problems at the wrong level. Ask yourself:

- Is this a tactical issue? → Delegate to your team.
- Is this a process issue? → Document and systemize.
- Is this a strategic issue? → Step in personally.

Clarity about where the problem really lives stops you from micromanaging and keeps your focus where it matters most.



3. THE TWO-WEEK RESET

- Block one afternoon every two weeks to step back.
- Review: What’s working, what’s breaking, what’s next?
- Re-align with your leadership team.
